Community Cruisers Rod Club

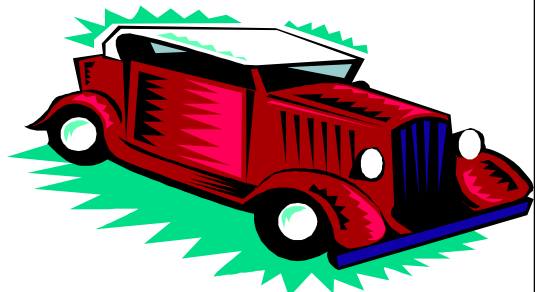

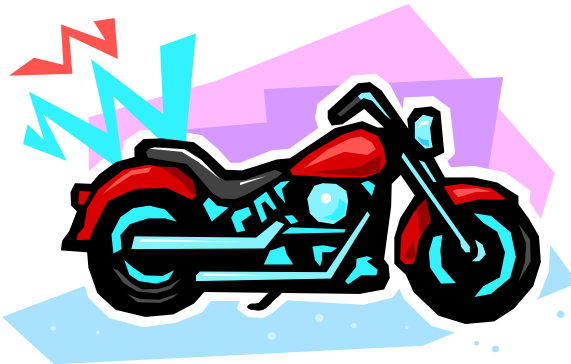

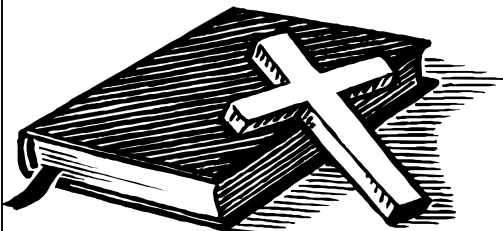
