Important Notes for October

1. Please join me in thanking God for and in welcoming Mr. Eric Darrow, Sr. to our staff as our newest Upper School teacher (and 3rd grade Latin teacher). Mr. Darrow will begin working full time at ECS beginning October 1, but will not take on his official teaching responsibilities until October 12, the Monday after Fall Break. He will be teaching the following courses: 6th Grade New Testament Survey II, 7th/8th grade Old Testament Survey II; 9th grade Hermeneutics (How to interpret & study the Holy Scriptures), 10th grade Systematic Theology (Drawing Christian Doctrine and truth from Romans and the Pauline Letters), 7th/8th grade Civics, 3rd grade Latin. In order to fit him into all these roles our schedule in the Upper School will be changing somewhat when we return from Fall Break.

2. Fast Facts on Mr. Eric Darrow, Sr. new Upper School teacher: Married to Patricia who is a Math

teacher in a Chatham County public school; 3 grown children, attends New Life Fellowship (Christian Missionary Alliance) in Savannah, resides in Savannah, served 20 years as a Naval Chaplain, 15 years plus as a pastor, 8 years experience in the classroom at Providence Christian School of Savannah, Holds a B.S. in Bible and Theology from Toccoa Falls College, Georgia, and a Master of Divinity from Trinity Theological Divinity School in Illinois.
