- 5. Approval of November Minutes:** Continued to next meeting.
- 6. Treasurer's Report:** Gary Zondervan reported the present checking account balance is \$23,224.93 and the present money market balance is \$31,605.21. We anticipate paying \$13,000 for the new track and field automated timing system in the near future, and still owe an additional \$3,500 for the Athletic Book.
- 7. Athletic book Update:** Approximately \$10,000 is still outstanding. Larry, Bernie and Malosi will make follow up calls to the outstanding companies.
- 8. Christmas Tree Sales:** Bernie reported that Boosters will net \$1,175.00 for Christmas Tree sales. Thank you for your efforts, Bernie!
- 9. Golf Tournament** - Friday, June 3, 2011: The first committee meeting was held on 1/5/11 with the next meeting on 1/ 26/11. The committee decided that we would have the brochure redesigned this year. The contract has been signed with the golf course. The committee discussed a hat and chair as a give away, at tonight's meeting a shirt was discussed.

The most important thing now is to work on raffle prizes and tee sponsors. A discussion was held with the coaches present about how best to get their athletes involved. Connie Leyva volunteered to talk to parents if coaches thought that would be helpful. Coaches, we thank you for your willingness to participate.

- 10. Booster Bin:** A blow out sale was held on December 30, 2010, which netted \$538.00. Thank you to Kim Nelson and Aurora Jubile for their help! The apparel committee met on 1/5/11 and came up with some new designs for a more modern up-to-date look. New logos have been approved by David Parkes. The logo for the Green and Gold day shirts

has been approved. Aurora Jubile has designed an order form and will start taking orders at the elementary school.

11. Coaches Reports:

- a. Girls basketball:** Coach Hoekstra reported the girls are 17-0 this year and could set the school record for most wins. They are ranked 16th in CIF Division 5A. Great job Lady Knights!
- b. Boys Soccer:** Coach Fakkema reported the boys are 7-1 in league and tied for first place. They are ranked #3 in CIF and 5th in the Inland Valley.
- c. Boys Basketball:** Coach Brummel reported the boys are 13-3 and 7-1 in league, they are ranked 7th in Division 4A. The program is strong overall.
- d. Softball:** Coach Huisman reported there are currently 10-12 girls out for softball. They are waiting for basketball and soccer to be over. 2 OC graduates will be assisting this year.
- e. Baseball:** Coach Love reported the team is young this year. They had their first scrimmage of the year and the opposing team loved the new field.
- f. Track and Field:** Coach Schaap reported track is starting up with great numbers this year, 30 boys and 30 girls and growing. We have a new shot put ring and league meets will be bigger this year. The OC Invitational will be at Chino Hills High on March 19, 2011.
- g. Girls Soccer:** Coach Belden reported girls varsity is still ranked but we lost a critical game to Woodcrest which puts us firmly in second place. The team could set a new school record for fewest goals allowed.
