

## **Ontario Christian Boosters Club Minutes of the March 23, 2009 Meeting**

4. **Coaches' Report:**
  - Boys Soccer** - Len Fakkema reported that the boys lost in the second round of the CIF playoffs to the eventual CIF champion, Mountain View. Tyler Struiksma was named league MVP. Six players were placed on the first, second or third all-CIF teams. The record for the season was 12-10-4.
  - Girls Soccer** - David Parkes handed out a written report from Coach Dave Belden as he was unable to attend. The girls were champions in the Christian League with an 9-0-1 record. They tied a school record with 17 shutouts. They were defeated in the CIF semi-finals by Desert Christian. Kaitlyn Mendoza was named Christian League Player of the Year and OC had five players selected to all-CIF teams. The girls had 23 wins which tied the third best in OC's history.

  - Girls Track and Field** - Len Fakkema reported that now that the soccer girls are back, the team is doing very well. They set a new 4 x 400 record at the OC Small Schools Invitational.
  - Boys Football** - David Parkes introduced Laing Stevens as OC's "new" football head coach. Laing thanked the Boosters for their support over the years and he is looking forward to improving the program. The summer football schedule will be on the website. There will be a football parent night on Wednesday, April 8, at 6:00 p.m.
  - Golf** - David Parkes reported that golf is doing well.
  - Boys Volleyball** - David Parkes reported that the boys are excited about their play and the possibility of making the CIF playoffs.
  - Boys Baseball** - Coach Ben Dykhouse and his wife had a baby boy. Mother and son are doing well. League will start next week.
