**Minutes of the November 24, 2008, Meeting**

1. **Opening Prayer:** Offered by Bernie Gabrielse.

3. **Coaches and Staff present:** Most coaches were at the teachers' convention. David Parkes and Dave Belden were present.

5. **Coaches report:**
  - Cross Country**--David Parkes reported that Zach Oliver won the CIF, Division IV, Cross Country meet and is ranked 3<sup>rd</sup> in the state.
  - Girls Tennis**--David reported OC Tennis advanced to the semi-finals and had a very good season.
  - Football**--David reported that the OC Football team lost its first round CIF game to Maranatha.
  - Girls Volleyball**--Nate reported that girls' volleyball finished second in league to Arrowhead Christian. Three girls earned the first team all-league with 2 girls on the second team. The JV team finished 7-3 in league. The Freshmen were 10-4 overall.
  - Girls Soccer**--Dave Belden reported that girls' soccer is just beginning. He expects that they will do well this season.
