8. Athletic Director's Report: David Parkes reported on the middle school combination softball/baseball field construction. The infield is fully graded and posts are in the ground. Fencing is due to start next week. Craig Cook commented that last year they experienced the new baseball program at the middle school. His son had a great experience and the other players and families really enjoyed the program. High School report: There is a used volleyball machine for sale. We own a used volleyball machine which we are not using. Mr. Parkes know an outside volleyball team who is interested in purchasing the used machine from us. As our teams are not and have not used this machine very much the last couple of seasons, we discussed the sale of it. A new Machine cost approx. \$2,700.00. Motion made and supported to have Mr. Parkes sell the machine at the best price possible. Passes. The sign for the press box at football stadium was discussed. Motion made and supported that the art and vendor bid be approved. Passed. The sign will be placed above press box and completed by the football season opener.
