

Junior High Procedures and Policies

1. **Binders:** Students should have a binder with all of their notebooks and folders. Everything will be in one place, and this should eliminate the need to go back to their lockers to get missing assignments and supplies.
2. **Restrooms:** Junior High students are to use the restrooms by Mr. Crull's room or by the gym. The restrooms by the lunchroom are for the lower grades.
3. **Doors:** Junior High students should not leave the building at the end of the day through the southwest door (at the top of the stairs). They must use the south doors or the door by the band room.
4. **Birthday Treats:** These treats are optional. Students must inform their homeroom teacher that they have brought a treat, and the teacher will decide when it is best to hand out the treat. Do NOT bring pop for birthday treats.
5. **Lunch:** For the first week, students will sit together as a class (homeroom) at lunch. If this goes well, teachers will allow students to sit where they wish. Teachers will monitor throughout the year if students need to go back to sitting in homerooms, or if they have to deal with a situation on an individual basis.
6. **Lockers:** These are a gift from the Guild! No stickers, padlocks, or inappropriate material on the inside or outside of the lockers.
7. **Study Halls:** Students must bring enough work for study halls to the classroom. Students must also bring a book along to read in case they get done with homework. Please see the study hall rules for more information.
8. **Tennis Shoes:** Tennis shoes must be worn for P.E. and intramurals. No exceptions.
9. **Gum:** No gum chewing is allowed.
10. **Covers:** All books will need covers.
11. **Assignment Notebooks:** Students must use assignment notebooks.
12. **Dress:** Junior High students must remember to dress appropriately. All shirts must have sleeves. Shorts need to be an appropriate length, and shirts must be long enough to cover the midriff.
13. **Late Assignments:** Please see the late assignments policy for more information.
14. **Morning Schedule:**
 - a. 8:00 – 8th graders are allowed to come in
 - b. 8:05 – the first bell rings, and all students may come into school
 - c. 8:15 – the second bell rings, and all students should get their books for first period and go quietly to their homerooms to take their seats for morning devotions
