

Study Hall Rules

- 1. Remember that study hall is a time to work on homework and projects, not a time to socialize or “zone out.” Practice good time management.**
- 2. Take all homework and supplies to study hall BEFORE the study hall begins. Those that need to go out to their locker during study hall will receive a strike.**
- 3. Take a book to read in case you finish work early. If you have to go back to your locker to get a book, you will get a strike. Teachers also have extra books in the room that you can read, or the study hall teacher may give you work to do.**
- 4. You need a pass to go to the library, locker, bathroom, or office. Go directly to your destination.**
- 5. No talking is allowed during study hall. It is up to the study hall teacher whether or not students will be allowed to work together.**
- 6. Laptops will only be available to students during Wednesday and Friday study halls.**
- 7. If you need to use a laptop, you must receive a pass from a teacher giving you permission BEFORE the study hall begins.**
- 8. Be in your seat and working before the bell rings.**
- 9. If you need help with homework, ask your study hall teacher first (they may refer you to a classmate), and then ask if you can talk to your subject area teacher.**
