

## **Jr. High Reminders...**

1. Students should have a binder with all their notebooks and folders. Everything will be in one place and this should eliminate the need to go back to the lockers to get missing assignments.

2. Restrooms-Jr. High students are to use the restrooms by Mr. Crull's room or by the gym. The restrooms by the lunchroom are for the lower grades.

3. Jr. High students should not leave the building at the end of the day through the southwest door (at the top of the stairs). They must use the south doors or the door by the band room.

4. Birthday treats-They are optional. Inform your homeroom teacher that you have brought a treat and he/she will decide when it is best to hand out the treat. Do **NOT** bring pop for birthday treats!

5. Lunch-For the first week we will sit together as a class (homeroom) at lunch. If this goes well we will let you sit anywhere. We will monitor through the year if we need to go back to sitting by homerooms, or if we have to deal with a situation on an individual basis.

6. Lockers-These are a **GIFT** from the Guild! No stickers, padlocks, or inappropriate material on the inside or outside of lockers.

7. Study halls-Students must bring enough work for study halls to the classroom. Students must also bring a book along to read in case they get done with homework early.

\*You will need a pass to go to the Computer Lab and to the Library with a purpose in mind. If you are not doing the activity specifically mentioned on the pass you may be asked to go back to your study hall.

\*Students are welcome to go to Mrs. Haack's room for study hall if you like. Please check with your study hall teacher.

8. Tennis shoes must be worn in the gym for P.E. and intramurals (no exceptions).

9. **NO** gum chewing!

10. All books will need covers.

11. Students must use assignment notebooks. 8th graders may use a notebook of their choice.

12. Jr. High students must remember to dress appropriately!! No spaghetti strap shirts, shorts need to be appropriate length, shirts must be long enough to cover “tummy”.

13. Late or Unacceptable assignment policy-An incomplete assignment, or one in which instructions are not followed would be considered unacceptable, will be recorded over a nine week period (not just per class-but combination of all classes).

**1st**-stay in at noon hour

**2nd**-stay in at noon and call goes home to parent

**3rd**-noon hour, call to parent, and in at 7am on Wednesday to work on school work

\*After third student will come in on Wednesday for each late assignment. The student will start “fresh” each nine week period.

**8:05**-first bell rings and all students may come into school (students are not allowed to come in and get playground equipment before school starts)

**8:15**-second bell rings and all students should get their books for first period and go quietly to their homerooms to take their seats for morning devotions
