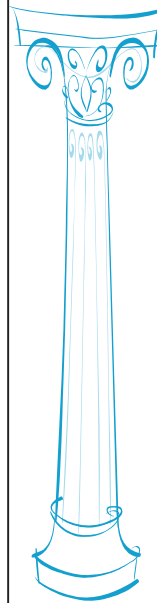

Renovation News - The Reservation of the Most Holy Eucharist - the Tabernacle

"In accordance with the structure of each church and legitimate local customs, the Most Blessed Sacrament should be reserved in a tabernacle in a part of the church that is truly noble, prominent, conspicuous, worthily decorated, and suitable for prayer" (*General Instruction of the Roman Missal, 314*). The

Tabernacle is to be located in the sanctuary of the church, preferably along the center axis of the church in the apse of the sanctuary; only with the permission of the Diocesan Bishop may the tabernacle be placed outside of the sanctuary. The magnificent Tabernacle at **St. Mary** will remain where it is. The Tabernacle at **St. Robert** was originally placed at a axis, behind the Altar. The Tabernacle will be returned to this place of prominence. ~Lynda
