What if ***‘doing the right thing’*** meant that you risked losing your job, jeopardizing your safety, and sent you and your family on a ten year odyssey of uncertainty and unbelievable stress? Would your Catholic values guide you to make the right choices and sustain you for the long haul?

For author and St. Mary Parish School Alumnus John Schilling, there never was a question about making the right choices. John will be at St. Mary, May 21st to talk about his experience and his new book entitled ***Undercover: How I Went from Company Man to FBI Spy - and Exposed the Worst Healthcare Fraud in US History.***

John, a Menomonee Falls native and 1976 graduate, fondly recalls and even mentions his alma mater in the book: “The school, run by the Franciscan sisters, was known for its rigorous curriculum and strict adherence to Catholic religious teachings. That upbringing at home and at school taught me to respect others, be honest, and strive to live with integrity.”

Suspenseful and provocative, *Undercover* tells the story of Schilling’s journey from ordinary citizen to federal informant. The book recounts how he allied himself with the FBI and the Justice Department and journeyed into an undercover world in which he carried a wire and mapped out offices for secret government raids. In the end, John’s values-based upbringing made all the difference in the world.

Mr. Schilling will speak during the day with school students on May 21st and is guest of honor at a special evening program. Please join John for 5:30 PM hospitality and his 6:00 PM presentation, with book signings to follow at 6:30 PM. The event will be held in the St. Mary Parish School Activity Center.
