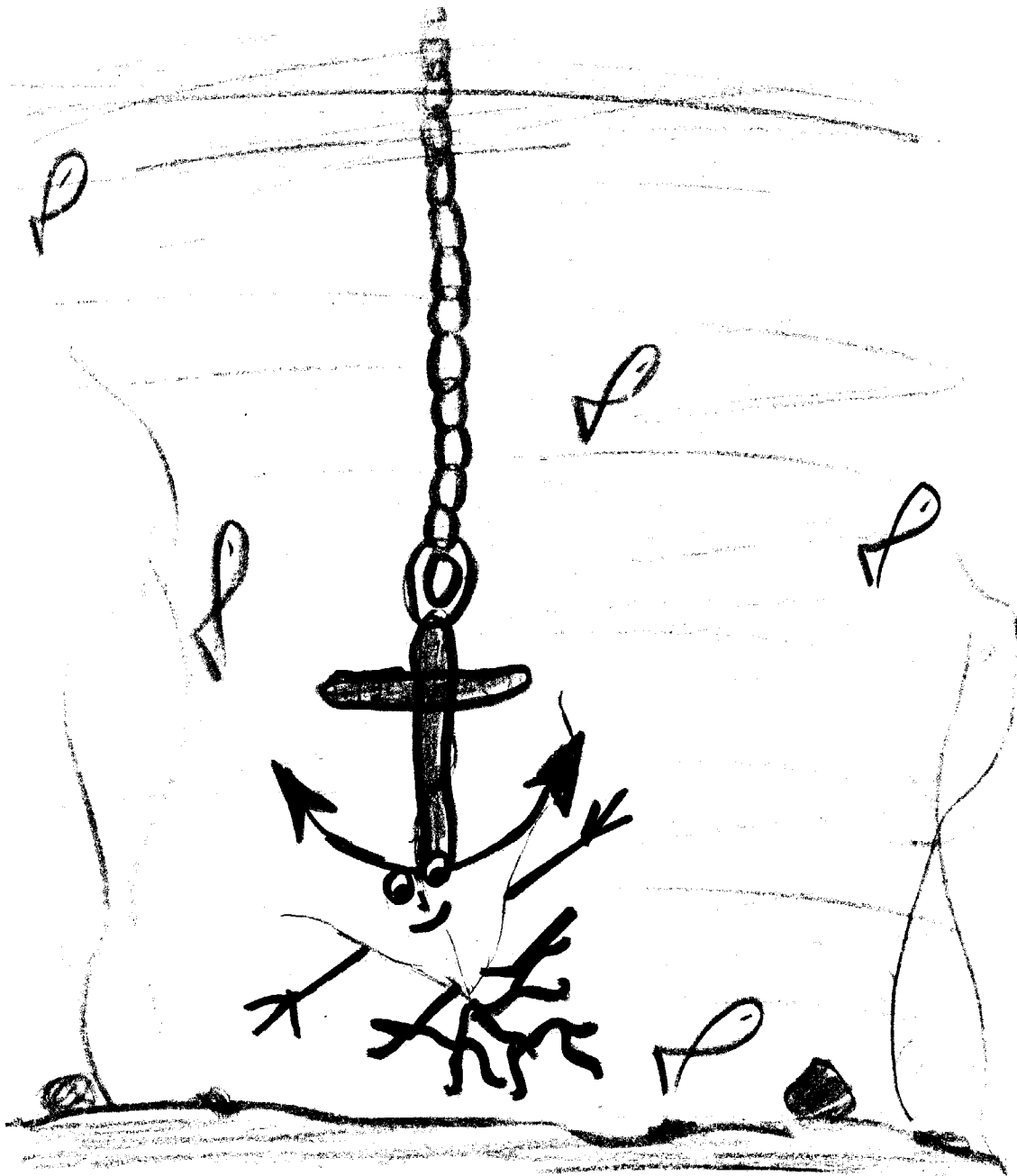
Can you find Mark?
