## Latest SCRIP Information

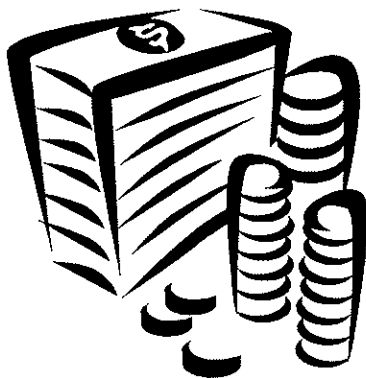
### What is Scrip?

Scrip means "substitute money". Vendors sell gift cards to St. Rita Scrip for less than face value. St. Rita Scrip sells them to you for face value. The difference in price is the profit to the school and the discount to your tuition account.

### Where does the profit go?

Half of the profit is returned to the school, less the expenses for operating the program. The other half is credited to the tuition accounts (St. Rita School, Religious Ed., or Boylan) of participating families.

Families can earn unlimited tuition credit just by purchasing Scrip and encouraging friends and family members to purchase also.
